Black Walnut from the Northern USA states of Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Northern Illinois and Northern Indiana provides a darker more even brown color, less sap, and tighter captured defects Black Walnut from the central United States.

Because production levels exceed 2,000m³ per month, we have the ability to supply large volumes of ripped-to-width Northern Black Walnut in our own Premium Grade as defined below. We also market our own Select Grade which is based on an enhanced NHLA FAS/1F grade and our Natural Grade which is sawn from the center of Northern Black Walnut logs in order to provide a heavy heartwood, character marked, natural-looking product. Our stock rip-to-width is perfect for single strip flooring manufacturers making engineered flooring.

Midwest's Premium Grade Walnut Planks represent the very best lumber sawn exclusively from veneer grade logs. Sawing from these logs provides improved clarity, as defects are limited to the occasional live knot with a maximum diameter of 26mm. The product is 100% heartwood, free of sapwood, and occasional sound, solid pin knots up to 8mm are allowed. Because this product comes from veneer logs, it is expensive, however for companies making wear layers for engineered flooring in an application requiring a high percentage of clear, sap free boards, this is the ideal option. Because of limited availability orders for Premium Grade plank might take additional time to develop when compared to Select Grade plank orders.
